<b>Barolo, Brunante, Ceretto, Piedmont, Italy, 2010</b>	<b>20</b>	<b>39</b>	<b>Pinot Noir, Flowers, Sonoma Coast, 2013</b>	<b>18</b>	<b>35</b>
"The 2010 Barolo plays all the right cards. This is a charming wine. It's one of the best made in the 2010 vintage with soft lines, firm structure and a bursting personality. The bouquet is brimming with Nebbiolo-driven aromas of anise seed, cola, licorice and white almond skin. Fruit tones are delicate and ethereal with cassis and dried raspberry at the front. In the mouth, the wine is graceful and silky." - 93 Points R. Parker			The Sonoma Coast's rocky, well-drained terrain and elevated proximity to the cool Pacific Ocean allow us to grow Pinot Noir with fresh, bright red fruit flavors, soft tannins, complex minerality and brilliant acidity. Our Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir is sourced from some of the finest family owned vineyards within the extreme Sonoma Coast appellation including Flowers’ Sea View Ridge Estate Vineyard. The grapes are harvested in the early morning hours to ensure the fruit arrives cool and freshly intact.

Altesino's 2010 Brunello di Montalcino stands proud among its peers. No other wine tasted among the new releases in Montalcino achieves this unique level of aromatic finesse and distinction. The bouquet is almost purely floral in character with a strong emphasis on pressed rose petal, dried violets and potpourri. The fruit tones are less emphatic and include bright cherry and red currant. In the mouth, the wine's compressed texture is accented by fennel seed and licorice. The 2009 vintage had more power and heat, but this version shows elegant restraint. - 93 Points R. Parker			A wine with all the hallmarks of the legendary Cabernets of Rutherford: deep, cassis-currant aromas, the classic notes of Rutherford Dust, earthen flavors of cedar and black olive and a velvety, plush mouthfeel.

The 2013 Châteauneuf du Pape La Bernardine came from yields of less than one ton per acre. It offers impressive depth of fruit, chalky minerality and medium to full-bodied richness on the palate. Like all of the Chapoutier releases in 2013, it has beautiful ripeness and quality tannin. It should drink nicely on release and evolve gracefully for 6-8 years. - 90 Points R.Parker			The impressive 2012 Reserve Tapestry, a blend of Bordeaux varietals, is more elegant and slightly less intense than the Private Reserve. It offers up sweet black cherry fruit notes intermixed with licorice, spice box and dusty, loamy soil undertones. Medium to full-bodied and deep with loads of ripe fruit, low acidity and sweet, velvety tannins, it can be enjoyed over the next decade. - 92 points R.Parker

Aromas of blackberry, blueberry and cassis mingle with hints of violet and dark chocolate to seduce and intrigue. The palate is inviting and silky, with a vivid core of cassis that define every sip, balanced by a backbone of acidity and a smooth tannin structure. This Bordeaux style wine’s never-ending, layered finish makes it enjoyable now or celarworthy through 2026.			The name of the wine, which translates to “highest in Altesi,” refers to the fact that the grapes for this wine are sourced from some of the estate's highest vineyards. This wine is made from a blend of equal parts Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot, all of which are hand-harvested in September. The wine is then aged for 12-14 months in French oak barriques. This wine comes together and brings you a bright ruby red color, aromas of dried black cherries and violet petals complement undertones of forest floor and leather. On the palate, the wine is full-bodied and well-structured with persistent berry flavors on the finish.

The red fruit brightens across the palate, picking up raspberry, spice and silky on the finish.

brilliant straw yellow with a green shimmer, pronounced and expressive aromas with flowery and somewhat spicy notes. Richly flavored with a slight smokiness and a fresh , clean finish.		A rich garnet color with a ruby edge, the wine opens to reveal lifted fruit aromas of bright strawberry and jammy fruit, mocha, and vanilla, along with toasty oak notes. Expressive boysenberry, blackberry, dark cherry, juicy strawberry, and toasty mocha flavors lend complexity and depth on the palate. The well-integrated oak provides structure and depth seldom seen in Pinot Noir.

Sweet and meaty on the entry, sweet and well structured tannins that result an harmonious and embraced mouth feeling.

On the palate, the wine is smooth, with silky tannins and bracing acidity, showing structural balance long into the finish.

Horin has a delicately fruity nose, its subtle flavors are well-balanced, and it is exceptionally smooth with a long clean finish.		Aromas of plum, chocolate truffles, graphite dust, blueberry, and caramel. A palate reminiscent of vanilla, sassafras, coffee and Bing cherry. The palate impression is succulent with powdered cocoa tannins and a savory finish.

This Rutherford Cabernet Sauvignon captures this area with briary blackberry, dark plum, black cherry, chocolate and tobacco leaf. The famous Rutherford Dust gives the wine cocoa-powder tannins and texture, while well-integrated oak adds toasty mocha notes to the generous aromas and expansive flavors.
